Fees

The Daily Betting Badge fees are as follows

- Fridays 14th & 28th
 - 5 x £20 - **£100**
 - RDT Racecourse Betting Compliance Fee - **£30** – fee applies for each pitch each day
 - Staff (if required) – **£20** per person
- Saturday 15th
 - 5 x £30 - **£150**
 - RDT Racecourse Betting Compliance Fee - **£30** – fee applies for each pitch each day
 - Staff (if required) – **£30** per person
- Saturday 29th – King George Day
 - 6 x £30 - **£180**
 - RDT Racecourse Betting Compliance Fee - **£30** – fee applies for each pitch each day
 - Staff (if required) – **£30** per person
- Saturday 12th August- Shergar Cup Day
 - 6 x £30 - **£180**
 - RDT Racecourse Betting Compliance Fee - **£30** – fee applies for each pitch each day
 - Staff (if required) – **£30** per person
- **Marketing Fee – One-off payment for the 2022/23 Jumps season - £100 – this must be paid on your first visit during the flat season**

Payment Details

- As is standard now, payment of the 'Daily Betting Badge, any Bookmakers Staff badges and the RDT Racecourse Betting Compliance Fee' will be required in advance (*the purchasing system allows for bookmakers to make their purchase up to midnight on the day before the raceday*)
- A wristband for all bookmakers and staff members will be required to access the racecourse and will be able to be collected on the day of racing – wristbands must be worn to access the racecourse. This is to enable the security team to be able to identify you and your staff and allow access to the course.
- Please help our teams by wearing the wristband not carrying it – they will be asked to stop you and ask you to wear the wristband – please help them and you to gain quicker access by wearing the wristband once you have collected it

Dropping off equipment

- Access can be arranged if you wish to drop equipment off early. All cars will need to be off course by 10.00am. You and any staff will have to be accredited by the venue operations team to access the racecourse. Please email me at least 1 week in advance of the meeting if this is required as this will take a little time to organise.
- All cars/vehicles will need to be removed by 10.00am – please do not try to gain entrance after 9.45am and please assist the security team in ensuring your vehicle is off course by 10.00am
